


Hallelujah (Shrek) Guitar Tabs and Chords

Hi, hope you enjoyed the video, and noticed the change of our usual logo during the song's demonstration at the beginning of the lesson ⁽²⁾ This is a rather simple one to learn, keep in mind that to play it in key, you'll need to place a capo to fret number 5, which transposes all of the notes you play up by 5 semitones.

These are the chords you'll be using to play Hallelujah:





Picking Pattern

Keep in mind that your thumb will be plucking the lowest string of any given chord:

- G major = low E string
- E minor = low E string
- D major = D string
- C major = A string
- B minor = A string



Intro Chord Progression






Verse Chord Progression






Walkup (from chord 7 to 8)
