

Silent Night Guitar Tabs and Chords

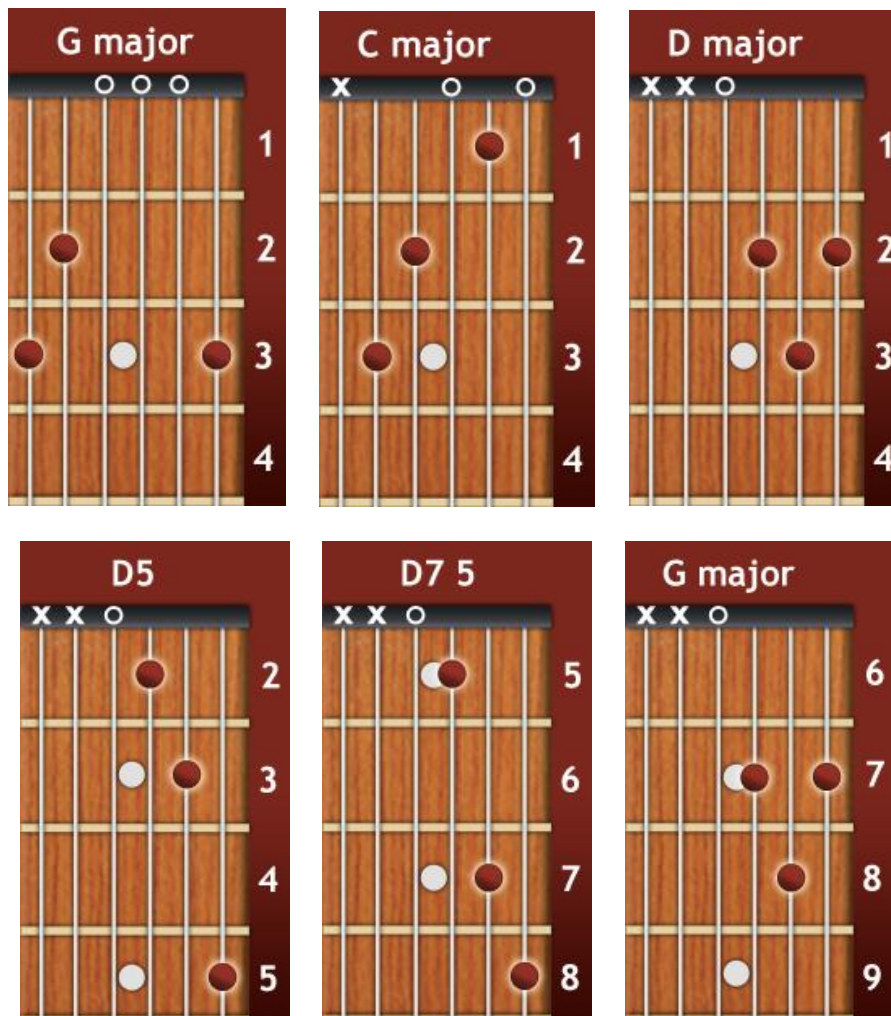

These are the chords you'll be using during Silent Night:



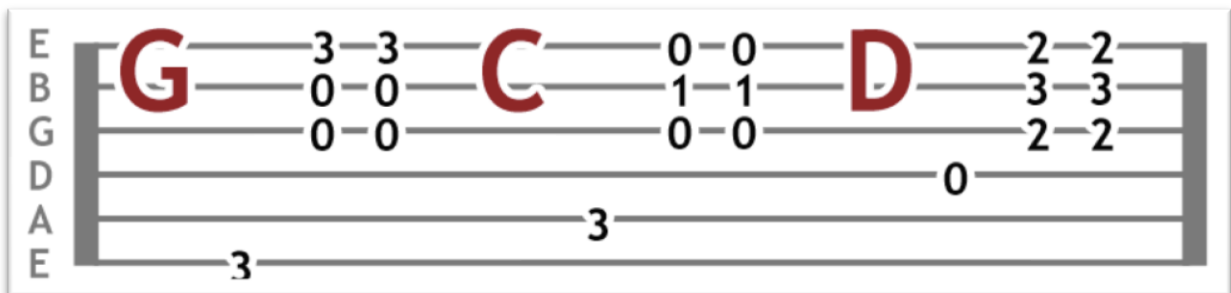
Chord Progression
