

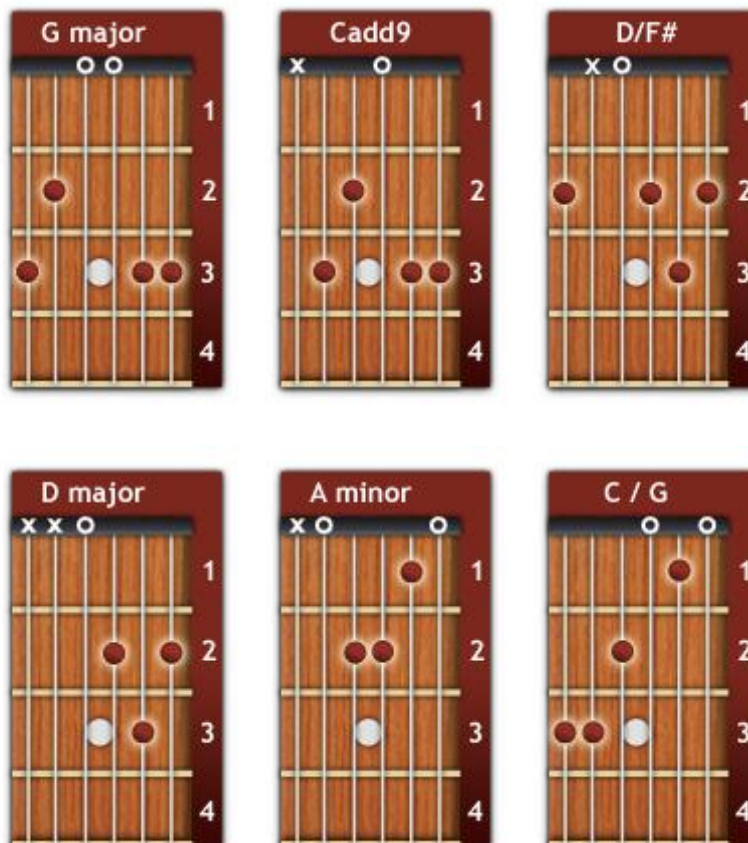
## Wish You Were Here Guitar Tabs and Chords



These are the chords you'll need to play the song:





## Intro 1












