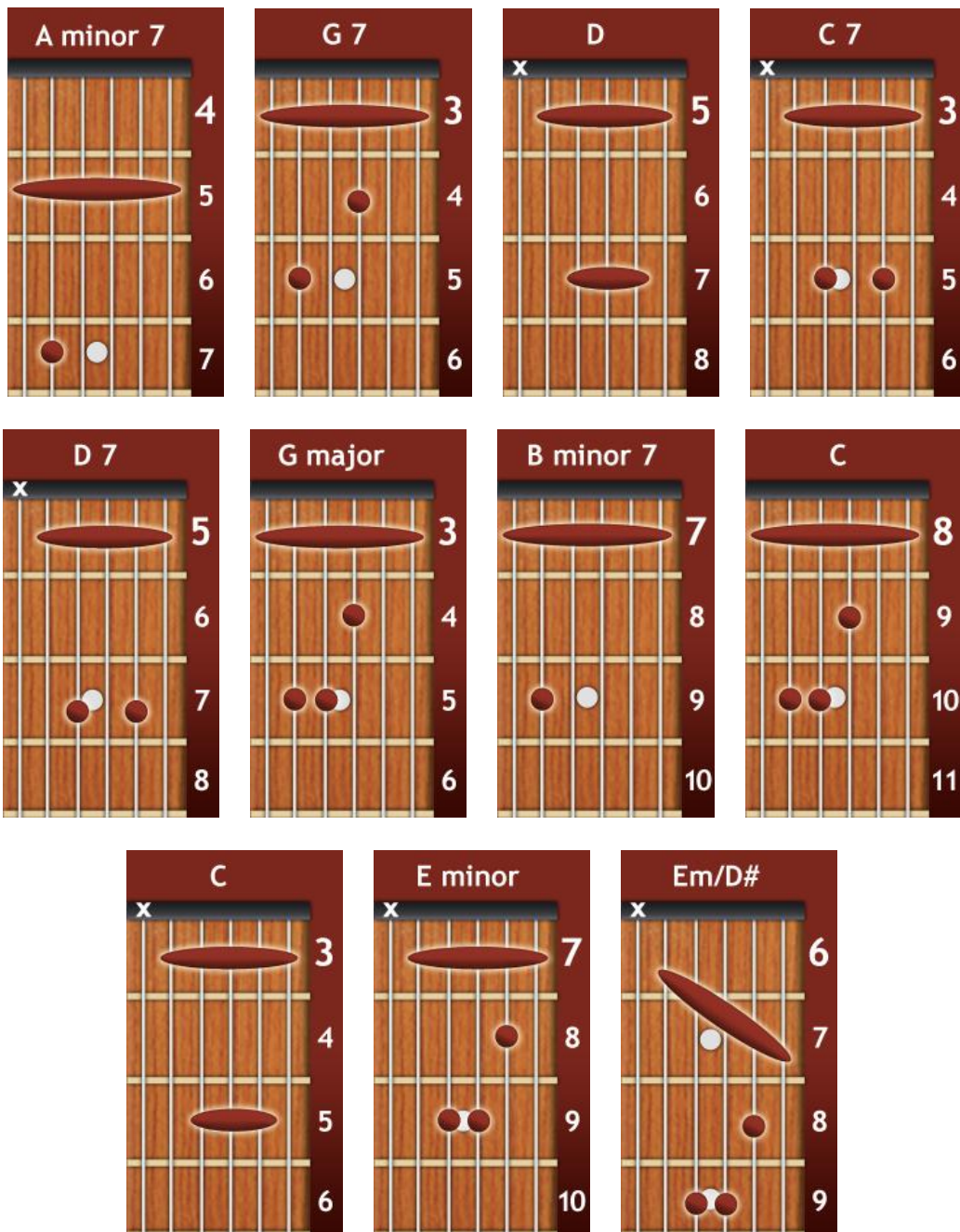


There are lots of tabs for this song that may be confusing at first, so make sure you have a look at the sequence of parts at the end of this document as well.

## Chords


