


House of the Rising Sun Guitar Tabs and Chords


Chords

These are the chords you'll need to play the song, practice the F major a lot. It's a bit difficult at first, but it'll come with enough practice.




Tabs - Arpeggio

Arpeggio 1





Arpeggio 2









Solo 1






