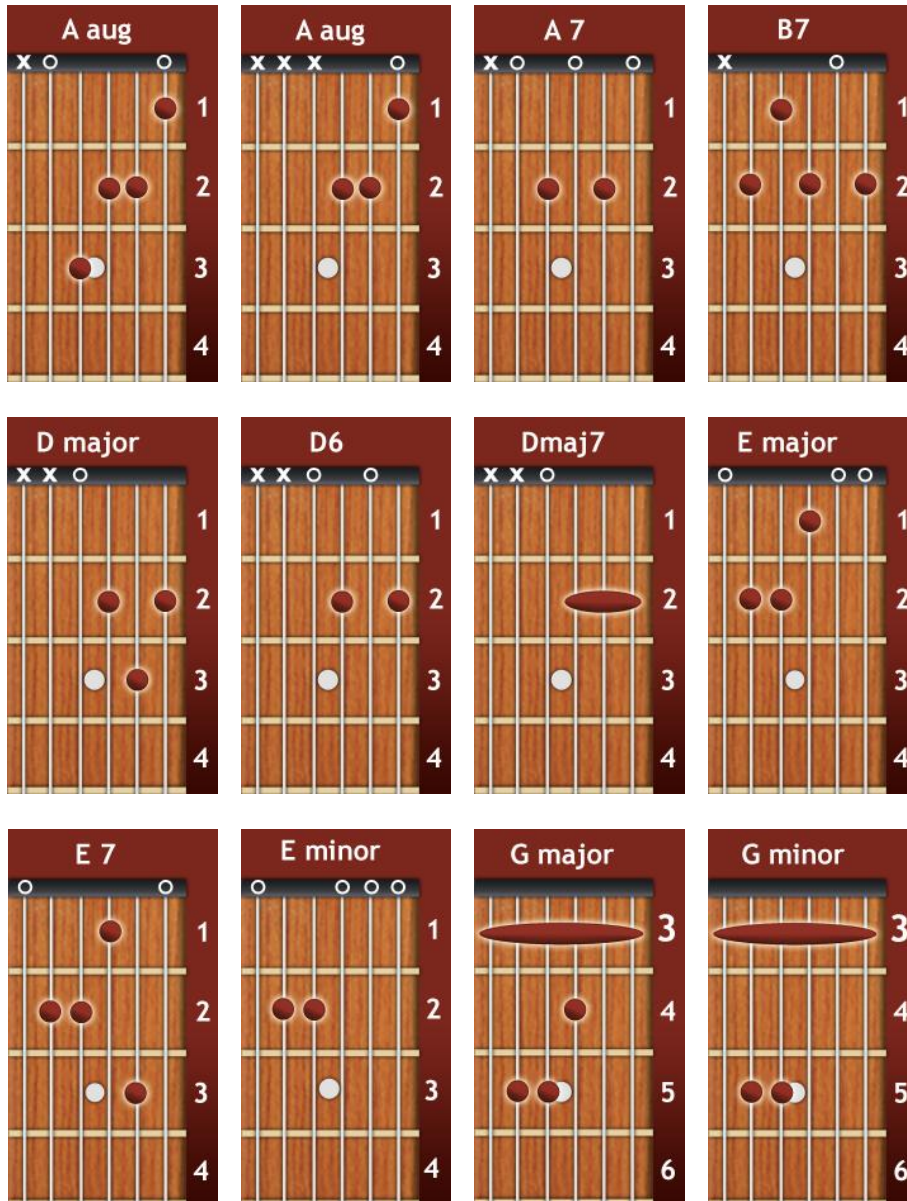





Bridge 1
