

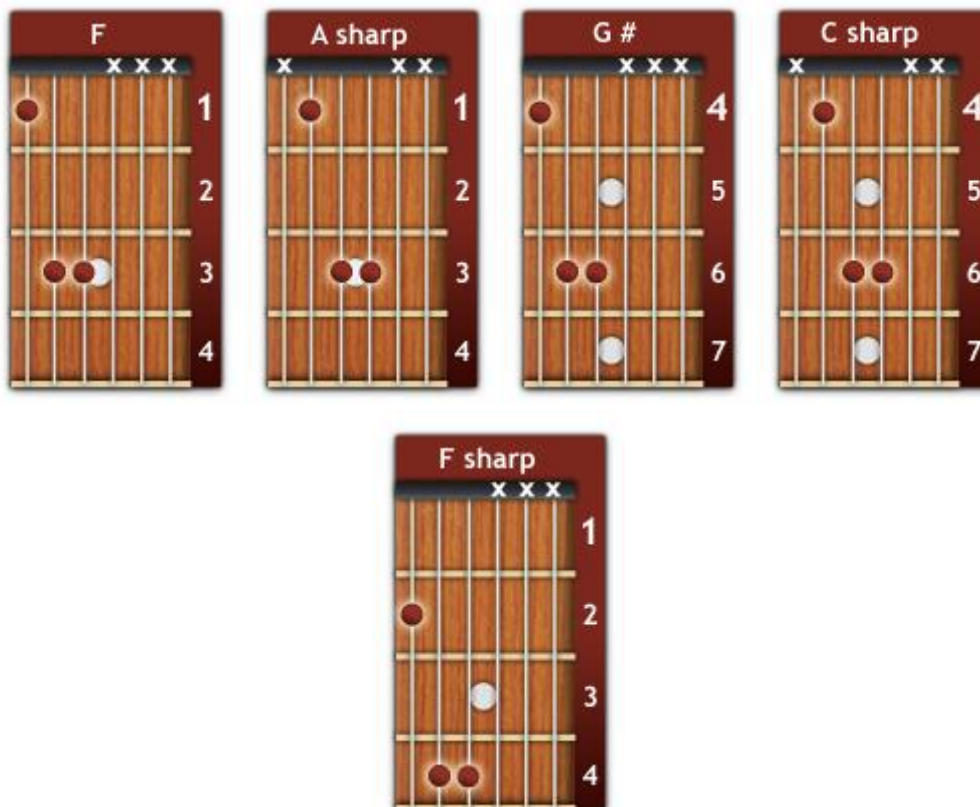
## Smells Like Teen Spirit Guitar Tabs and Chords

These are the power chords you'll be using in this song:

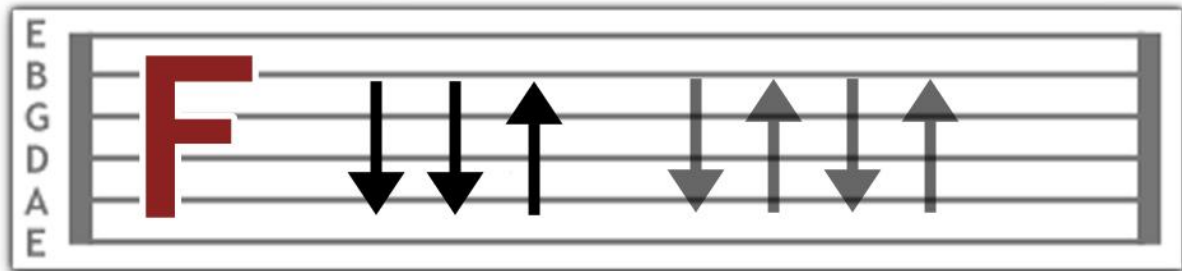

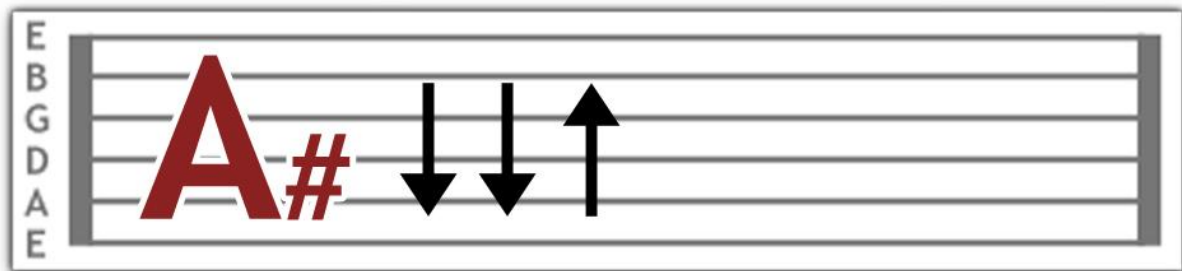

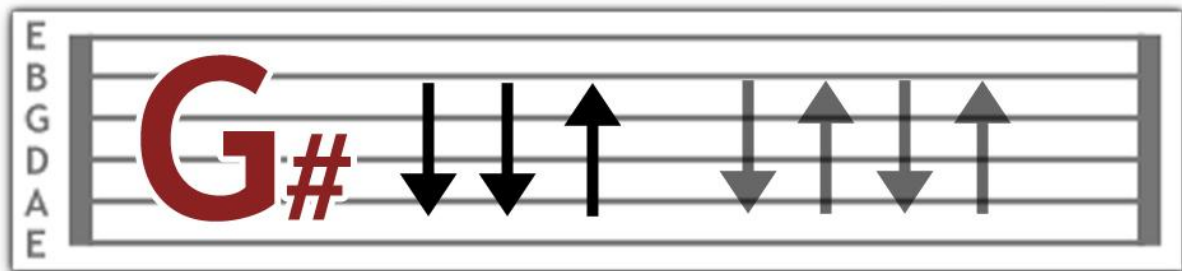





Verse





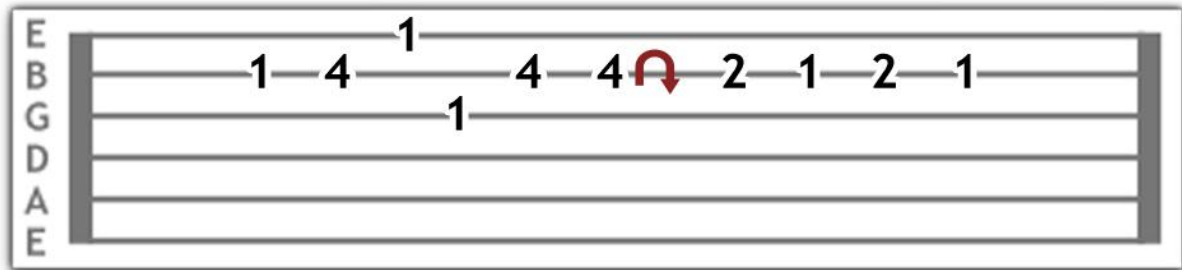

Bridge 2

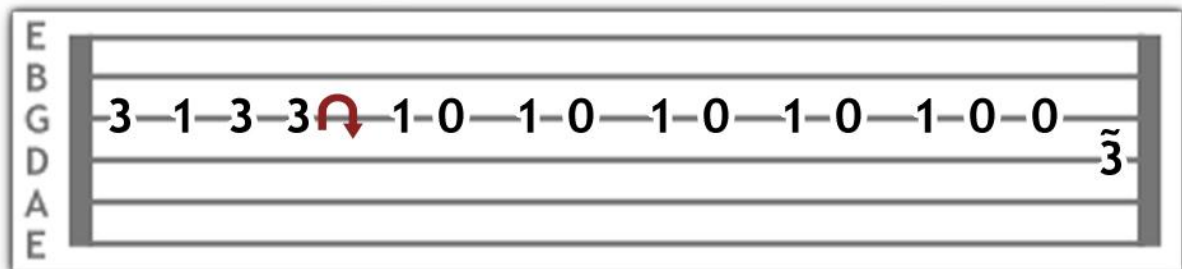
